In order to commemorate African women’s month, Lesotho Council of Non-Governmental Organisations (LCN) through the **YALI** Civic Leadership Programme has organised a seminar on “The Case of Senate Masupha and its implication on gender based discrimination in Lesotho” on Friday, 19 August 2016 at State Library American Corner.

The seminar is intended to build the capacity of the youth and Mandela Washington Fellows (18-35) on areas of advocacy against Gender Based Discrimination.

LCN is currently implementing a programme on Civic Leadership with the support of American Embassy Maseru. This programme integrates with the **Young African Leaders Initiative Innovation Hub implemented** as American Corner, State Library Maseru. The Leadership Innovation Hub provides the tools, opportunities and leadership skills tailored to empowering young African leaders in entrepreneurship, public sector management, and civic society.

The YALI Leadership Innovation Hub is built on existing institutional capacity in Lesotho to provide high quality training, mentoring, and networking support to a greater number of young leaders than can be reached through the **Mandela Washington Fellowship**. As a result, Lesotho Council of NGOs was tasked with providing civic leadership to exceptional young leaders between the ages 18 and 35 from a wide range of backgrounds and diverse experiences and education level.

In the past, **LCN** has convened seminars from reputable civil society leaders to inspire the youth on matters of civic leadership and defending human rights.
